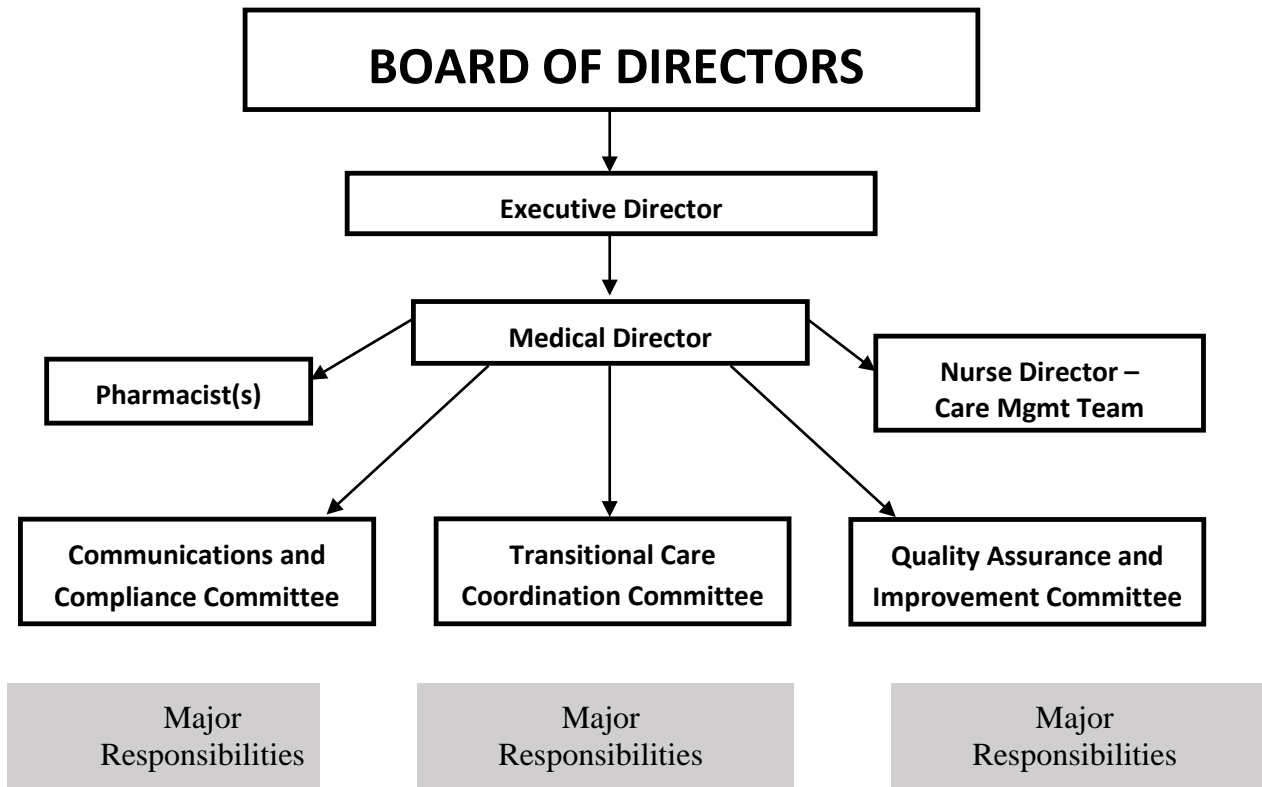


Organizational Chart and Leadership

- Major Responsibilities**
1. Health Information Exchange and ACO Budget and Financial Planning.
 2. Design and develop Shared Savings Distribution methodology for Board approval.
 3. Claims and Quality reporting.
 4. Develop ACO patient materials and patient engagement strategies.
 5. Develop the physician & patient education materials/symposiums.
 6. Compliance training.

- Major Responsibilities**
1. Review root causes for readmissions and provide summary reports for Medical Team.
 2. Develop best practice protocols for Obs/Adm in Hospitals and SNFs; provide monthly oversight.
 3. Develop evidence-based medicine protocols for care transitions/coaching; assess.
 4. Design key techniques for ACO transitions in care.

- Major Responsibilities**
1. Track and report 33 ACO quality measures as required by CMS.
 2. Address any patient concerns; notify ACO providers of concerns and remedies.
 3. Define/enforce remedial process for non-compliant providers.
 4. Develop Continuous Quality Improvement process for ACO.
 5. Develop protocols for Disease State Management on high risk population.
 6. Review adherence to guidelines and report to Committee.
